MINUTES OF MEETING

JULY 9, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 6:30p.m.

Members in attendance were: Tom Garcia, Tom Mosher, Miles Randall, Maury Frietas, Ken Gauthier, Marty Haracz, Andy Goudeau, Rhonda Tretsven.

Approval of minutes as written from last month. Motion Maury Frietas, Andy G second, board approved.

Treasurer Report: Rhonda reported that after monthly expenses the Checking account held \$5,961.34, while the savings for the "building fund" held \$1,013.00 both totaling \$6,974.34.

Membership Report: Andy reported that there are 95 members. 63 working, 16 non-working, 2 junior members, 14 life members.

OLD BUSINESS

Bob Boggs Insurance covering non-owned auto as per the City of Escondido requirement, we are waiting for proof of insurance to supply the city.

Sadler Insurance refunded \$750.00 /general-liability to Bear State. We were able to get this refund because their policy could not meet the needs that complied with our/city request for coverage for non-owned auto. They did not refund the part of the policy covering Directors/ officers-equipment coverage. We are covered under IBO until the end of the year. The D &O and equipment will be carried by Sadler Insurance, and the IBO will be in place for the general Liability until we get paper work from Boggs Insurance Agency.

Marty reported that the June shoot results reflected another event of 100 plus archers in attendance. With over 65 non-member shooters!

Treasurer Position- officially transferred to Rhonda Tretsven at the bank.

NEW BUSINESS

Pin order- Running out of 28 target shoot awards/pins. Pins have been reordered per Maury at 200/1st, 100/2nd, 100/3rd place, at \$1.95 each. We may have to use old wood medallions for July??? Pins usually last the club 2 years.

Shoot calendar 2008- Marty presented two outlines of shoot schedules. One with Reinhart as a scheduled shoot, and one with out. Board agreed to skip Reinhart next year due to non-communication and commitment of dates from Reinhart.

There was a possible conflict with Easter for March shoot. Rescheduled to March 30th (5th Sunday), 28 target shoot.

April Bear Creek shoot was discussed that to make it an 8am start time? Still to be discussed.

Consideration was asked by CBH/SAA that no Club shoots be scheduled during a weekend State Shoot, if they fall within a 100 mile radius of the event. This is difficult for all clubs, because the State shoots are not decided until January 2008. We will go with what we have at presently scheduled. Rhonda (SBAA), added that CBH/SAA is working on splitting the State Shoots to North and South (Field/Broadhead) that way there is more participation, and the cost of traveling is kept in perspective. Scores from both ends would be combined, and winners would be announced at a later date once all scores are collected. That is their concern about clubs holding shoots that conflict.

Marty will revise new schedule and give to Rhonda to submit to CBH/SAA for 2008.

Marty brought up the possibility of adding a new shoot- INJURED WARRIOR PROGRAM. This is an existing program on Camp Pendleton for recently injured area Military. Board was open to the idea; however, we will table this until further information is gathered for August's meeting.

Work Party- Andy reported that there is a work party scheduled for this weekend. Duties include: trails weed whacked, rebanding target butts, drag, and create brush piles etc. He also noted that the e-mail notices issued to members was working well with response to work from members.

DISCUSSION

Eagle Project- Nolan an Eagle Scout, has expressed interest in completing his requirements for his Eagle badge using Bear State as his community project requirement. Rhonda will contact Nolan and request he present his idea at the next board meeting in August.

Product Co-coordinator- Andy announced that Miles Randall has expressed interest in taking over the open board position of Product Co-coordinator.

T-Shirts-An order has been requested by Andy that we order new t-shirts, because our inventory is low. Discussion on whether to change the logo was brought up. Board will stick to new logo and add a small logo to the front of the shirts. There was an expression by Tom Moser that we purchase polo shirts (tan) in our new order. Board agreed to purchase 100 shirts (price break). Tom Garcia motioned, Ken Gauthier 2nd.

October 42 shoot-Will be changed (only this year) from the Bear Creek Wilderness Challenge/Marked Yardage to the Sleepy Hallow Challenge. This will be a mixed shoot of paper and 3D targets. Paper will be the characters from Sleepy Hallow and other Halloween characters. 3D targets will be dressed in costume....perhaps even a headless horsemen??? Rhonda is forming "decorating, drawing, painting etc" committee for this event. Miles Randall has offered to assist.

With no further discussion items being presented the board adjourned at 7.34pm

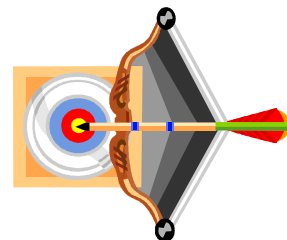
